Truth Something To Be Discovered

Some people say they are still following Jesus, but are walking away from God's truth. They're no longer believing that people need to trust Jesus to be saved and rescued from Hell (some don't believe in Hell at all), and are no longer affirming that the Bible is entirely true or that Jesus is the only way to Heaven (John 14:6). They're following the latest drifts of culture and trying to be popular on social and moral issues, rather than holding on to God's revealed truth in Scripture.

Jesus said some strong words: "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 10:32-33). Paul said, "I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes..." (Romans 1:16-17). In The Fellowship of the Ring, Bilbo Baggins says to his young cousin, "It's a dangerous business, Frodo, going out your door. You step onto the road, and if you don't keep your feet, there's no knowing where you might be swept off to."

To "keep our feet" in this world requires putting our weight upon what is true.

Nothing in the world can take the place of truth. Yet we are constantly bombarded with lies that attempt to do just that. Truth is not something we invent, only something we can discover. God reveals it to us in His Word. Truth is rooted in the eternal, all-powerful, and unchangeable God. Therefore, His promises cannot fail: "Every word of God proves true" (Proverbs 30:5 ESV).

The Holy Spirit leads people into truth (John 16:13). We're commanded to know the truth (1 Timothy 4:3), handle the truth accurately (2 Timothy 2:15), and avoid doctrinal untruths (2 Timothy 2:18). Christ's disciples do the truth (John 3:21) and abide in the truth (John 8:31-32). The "belt of truth" holds together our spiritual armor (Ephesians 6:14). God "does not lie" (Titus 1:2). He is "the God of truth" (Isaiah 65:16 ESV).

When we wonder what's right, we're to turn to God's Word: "For the word of the Lord is right and true" (Psalm 33:4).




